

Minutes August 4, 2016

The Minersville Town Council held a regular council meeting on August 4, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. at the Minersville Town Hall.

Council present: Ward Dotson, Barry Marshall, Jared Woolf, Brady Carter and Todd McMullin, Town Marshal Kevin Carter and Town Clerk Cherie Wood.

Visitors: Bill Garrett

Jared Woolf gave an opening prayer

Mayor Ward Dotson opened the meeting at 7:00 p.m

Minutes: Barry Marshall made a motion to approve the minutes from the July 7th 2016 council meeting without additions or corrections. Jared Woolf seconded the motion; all voted in favor, the motion passed.

Bill Garrett would like to put a modular home on the property at 65 South 400 West, for Paul Martin. The council reviewed his plans and his set backs. There will be no impact fees because the water and sewer hook ups are already there from a previous home. He was told that the sewer runs on a 90 degree angle from the neighboring house.

Brady Carter made a motion that the town gives Bill Garrett a building permit for a home at 65 S 400 W. Jared Woolf seconded the motion; all voted in favor, the motion passed.

The council discussed the cleaning and maintaining of the park restrooms. Brandon Davis has been opening each morning and locking them each night that he works. He has also spent about 6 hours cleaning them which he has put in over time hours. Valirie Short has expressed to Cherie that she would open and close them and clean and stock them during the summer if the council would consider letting her use the concession stand. The Council decided to let Brandon continue to take care of them this year and they will consider Valirie or someone else next year. The restrooms will be winterized in Oct.

Brandon Davis has been using his personal cell phone for work calls. He would like to ask the council if they would consider giving him a cell phone allowance to help pay for his bill or if they would get a work phone for him. The Council discussed the discount that Verizon gives government employees, they would also like to know how many calls he get a month that deals with work. Cherie will ask Brandon what cell phone company he is with and if he gets the government discount. They will make a decision next month.

Brady Carter made a motion to pay the bills. Barry Marshall seconded the motion; all voted in favor, the motion passed.

Other Business:

The groundbreaking for the new EMS building in Minersville will be on Aug 8, at 11:00 a.m Kevin would like the Council to wait until the sewer lines settle up at Lyle Carters new home before they make any decisions to pave the road in front of Shay Goff's.

Beaver County will be chip sealing the roads in Minersville within the next few weeks.

Todd McMullin made a motion to adjourn, Jared Woolf seconded the motion.
